
8M March in downtown Rio

CAMTRA'S BIRTHDAY 27



In 2022, Camtra published the study "Female Domestic Workers and Work Similar to Slavery." The number of women rescued from this type of work persists and demonstrates the significant challenges we still face in respecting the rights of one of the categories in which most women work. Camtra continues to report these cases on social media and hopes to increasingly contribute to the fight for domestic workers' rights.

TRABALHADORA DOMÉSTICA, 62 ANOS
Trabalhou por **15 anos** para uma família, na Zona Oeste do Rio de Janeiro.
Foi resgatada, pelo Ministério Público do Trabalho do estado (MPT-RJ) e pela Polícia Federal, em situação de trabalho análogo à escravidão, sem folgas, descanso semanal ou férias, no dia **3 de abril de 2024**.

TRABALHADORA DOMÉSTICA, 73 ANOS
Trabalhou por **20 anos** sem folga, para uma idosa de 99 anos, em Itapetininga, interior de São Paulo.
Foi resgatada por auditores fiscais no dia **18 de junho de 2024**. Ficava 24 horas à disposição da família contratante.

TRABALHADORAS DA INDÚSTRIA TÊXTIL, 19 E 22 ANOS
Foram resgatadas em ação fiscal contra o trabalho análogo à escravidão, iniciada em 20 de maio de 2020, em São Paulo.
Trabalhavam das 7h às 22h, em uma oficina de costura que confeccionava peças de vestuário para uma loja de varejo na capital paulistana, recebendo valores inferiores à metade de um salário mínimo.

TRABALHADORA DOMÉSTICA, 50 ANOS
TRABALHADORA DOMÉSTICA RESGATADA EM SITUAÇÃO DE TRABALHO ANÁLOGO A ESCRAVIDÃO (PORTO SEGURO-BA)
Mantida na condição análoga à escravidão por 44 anos, na Bahia. Será indenizada em 500 mil.
“Trabalhando para o filho da ex-patroa, sofreu maus tratos e pediu ajuda, que veio por uma amiga da vizinha e depois uma advogada que buscou ajuda nos órgãos públicos pelo Centro de Referência em Assistência Social (CREAS) e pelo Ministério Público do Trabalho (MPT).”



LIVES - SOLIDARITY ACTIONS



The environmental tragedy in Rio Grande do Sul in late April 2024 left the entire capital, metropolitan region, and other cities isolated after heavy rains caused by a historic flood of the Guaíba River. It was the rainiest month in the city's history. This climatic event once again exposed how gender issues can be exacerbated in exceptional situations. From the need for sanitary pads, cramp medication, contraceptives, and care for pregnant women, to reports of harassment and rape against women, adolescents, and children who were taken to shelters. Camtra worked to raise awareness of the violation of women's rights in Rio Grande do Sul, speaking with local leaders and strengthening the solidarity network among women.


NATIONAL EVENTS



The **3rd National Meeting of the World March of Women (WMW)**, titled "Nalu Faria," took place in Natal, Rio Grande do Norte, from July 6th to 9th, bringing together over a thousand women from 23 Brazilian states to discuss the current situation, build alternatives, and strengthen the movement's organization. The meeting also paid tribute to Nalu Faria, founder and historic feminist, who passed away in October 2023.

The meeting was divided into three main areas: interpreting the current situation, building alternatives, and organizational change. Strategies to confront conservatism and the offensive of conservative forces in Brazil and around the world were discussed, as well as feminist economics and the WMW's 6th international action in 2025.

Camtra was present in the form of General Coordinator Eleutéria Amora and Logistics Advisor Antônia Rodrigues.

Camtra organizes and also takes part in events marking women's commemorative dates. It is also invited to speak at events focused on women's rights. Below we highlight some of the events held in 2024.




Talking Circle with Minister of Women Cida Gonçalves - On May 11, the Minister hosted feminist organizations to discuss public policies for women in Brazil. The event was organized by the State Secretariat for Women of the Workers' Party (PT/RJ). We had the opportunity to discuss the rights violations we face and how feminist and women's movements can contribute to strengthening the Ministry of Women and also to policymaking.

On November 25th, **International Day to Combat Violence Against Women**, a crucial date for feminist activism, Camtra participated in the coordination and activity at Cinelândia, in partnership with the Women's Commission, the Commission to Combat Racism, the Feminist Uprising against Femicide, REDEH, the Articulation of Brazilian Women (AMB), and the Front for the Legalization of Abortion. The main objective was to raise awareness of the Municipal Program to Combat Femicide, presented by our mandate, approved by the City Council, but never implemented by the Rio de Janeiro City Hall.



The **Seminar on Care Work, Public Policies, and Women's Autonomy** was held on May 10th in the Session Room of the Federal Justice Cultural Center in Rio de Janeiro. Organized by Sisejufe, the seminar aimed to discuss the importance of care work and its relationship with public policies and women's autonomy. The event featured several speakers throughout the day, including our General Coordinator, Eleutéria Amora.



Eleutéria Amora, General Coordinator of Camtra, was interviewed in the report that addressed data from the 2022 census on the growing number of women heading Brazilian households, on the Repórter Brasil program, on TV Brasil, on October 28.

VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN: CRIMES OF THE PATRIARCHY

The Crimes of Patriarchy survey is conducted and published monthly by CAMTRA with the goal of preserving the memory of women victims of femicide in Brazil, as well as strengthening resistance and seeking justice for them and their families. By recording and disseminating this data, we seek to keep these women's stories alive. Information is collected from journalistic sources. We analyze articles published in major media outlets, local newspapers, and regional blogs.

To ensure greater accuracy, each registered case is verified through at least three to four different sources. Even with this effort, it is not possible to capture all femicides that have occurred in the country.





